We have been busy with the park. We went and picked up a new monster truck the Park purchased. Lon Castor and his girlfriend stained it and we got it all set up in the Park. Have been seeing a lot of kids playing on it. Plan on getting 2 loads of mulch for the Park playground. I would like to do more work in the park, just don't have the time or man power. I pull one of the guys off a job to mow and it leaves me shorthanded with trying to get the road work done that needs to be done.

Have been doing some work in the cemetery, fixing a stone that had tree damage. Replaced a pipe and ditched a spot on Spaulsbury Rd where when it rained, stone would wash in the road. The Town of Albion has come down and helped us a couple days, but I understand they have their own jobs going on as well, the Town of Orwell helps them out a lot as well. We are going to be doing some chip sealing for them and we are going to be using their grader to cut shoulders here in our town. We did barrow their broom, but took it back so they could sweep their roads. It will seem nice that we have our own broom so when we do any ditching or road work we can sweep it all when we are done with the work.

Took 05 Inter and the 2013 Inter to get inspected, there is a problem with the 2005 Inter with the back brake canister, so it won't pass. It is scheduled to be sent out to be fixed so it will pass inspection.

Will have the Cemetery, Town Hall, and Park all mowed and trimmed for Memorial Day weekend.

It's starting to look better here at the Highway Garage, getting rid of stuff we don't use or need anymore, but still a long ways to go.

I have in store for a very, very busy summer. There is a lot of projects that I have planned through out summer.
